#### Graduates' Career Outcomes Report 2023-24 Executive Summary

The Franklin University Graduates' Career Outcomes Report is a summary of employment and continuing education decisions made by Franklin University students who earned their degree during the 2023-24 Academic Year. The data for this report was generated by a survey of graduating students, which was administered via an electronic survey platform.

**Survey**. The purpose of the survey was to collect career outcomes data for Franklin's undergraduate and graduate degree recipients. A web-based survey was created and administered by the Office of Career Development. This survey was sent by email to those students who met the qualifications for graduation during the Fall and Spring terms of the 2023-24 Academic Year. Questions in this survey focused on collecting employment status, employer, job title, and continuing education information.

**Respondents and Response Rates.** This survey was administered to 1672 undergraduate students, just prior to their graduation. There were 646 undergraduate respondents, giving this group a response rate of 38.6%. Additionally, this survey was distributed to 904 graduate students and prompted 320 responses, for a response rate of 35.4%. Finally, 75 doctorate students received this survey, of which 34 participated. The response rate for these students is 45.3%. Response rates for the individual colleges and academic programs within those colleges are provided in this report.

**Career Outcomes Definition.** The total number of respondents who are either: working full-time, or continuing education (enrolled in a program).

**Career Outcomes Rates.** 2023-24 undergraduate degree earners who participated in the graduating students' survey had a career outcomes rate of 82.5%. 2023-24 graduate degree earners, who responded to the same survey, had a career outcomes rate of 75.3%. The doctorate degree earners who participated in this survey had a career outcomes rate of 79.4%. Career Outcome Rates for the individual colleges at the undergraduate and graduate level are provided in this report.












